Clerks Report – May 2010

The Council has been informed of the upcoming works on High Street, Debenham, that are due to commence on the 17<sup>th</sup> May for two weeks. The works will take place on the Western verge, South of the junction with Derry Brook Lane.

I have finally managed to speak with a planning officer and have been able to get a response to most of the queries listed at the last meeting regarding planning application 0360/10. A record of these notes has been e-mailed to the Council.

I have written to Mr. Phil Tallant and informed him of Mr. Berry Baxter's resignation. I have also requested that he put in motion the necessary procedure for advertising the vacancy.

I have booked a space in the next Cilca course, which is due to start on July 19<sup>th</sup>, for three consecutive Mondays.

I worked a number of additional hours last month. This was mainly due to the fact that we had three meetings and I started putting together the documentation for the year end accounts. I will inform the Council of the total and request your approval for payment at the June meeting.

I have not had had reply from Moon Beaver to date, therefore cannot progress this matter any further for the time being.

After reporting the loose floor slab in Henniker Road to both Suffolk County Council and Mid Suffolk District Council, it was determined that this was in privately owned land and that the street's residents were responsible for it's repair.

I have arranged to go to Barclays Bank in order to collect the necessary forms for a new mandate and Council should be able to complete these at the next meeting.
